to assassin bugs but are smaller (1/2 inch long) and specialize in preying on insects that are visiting flowers (Figure 8) They hide within the flower and kill unsuspecting wasps, flies, bees, and butterflies However, immature ambush bugs live on other parts of the plant and contribute more to the garden pest

BEES AND WASPS Order: Hymenoptera (excluding ants) Antennae tend to be club-shaped in butterflies and feathery in moths Notes: The adult form of our caterpillar friends! do not build a web, like jumping spiders TRUE BUGS Order: Hemiptera Suborder: Heteroptera Identification: Semi-transparent wings overlap so as to make a triangle

What is "Pollination" & What is a "Pollinator?" • The act of "pollination" occurs when pollen grains are moved between two flowers of the same species by wind or animals Successful pollination results in the production of healthy fruit and fertile seeds, allowing plants to reproduce Without pollinator
